Glass Tealight Lamp



Materials Required:

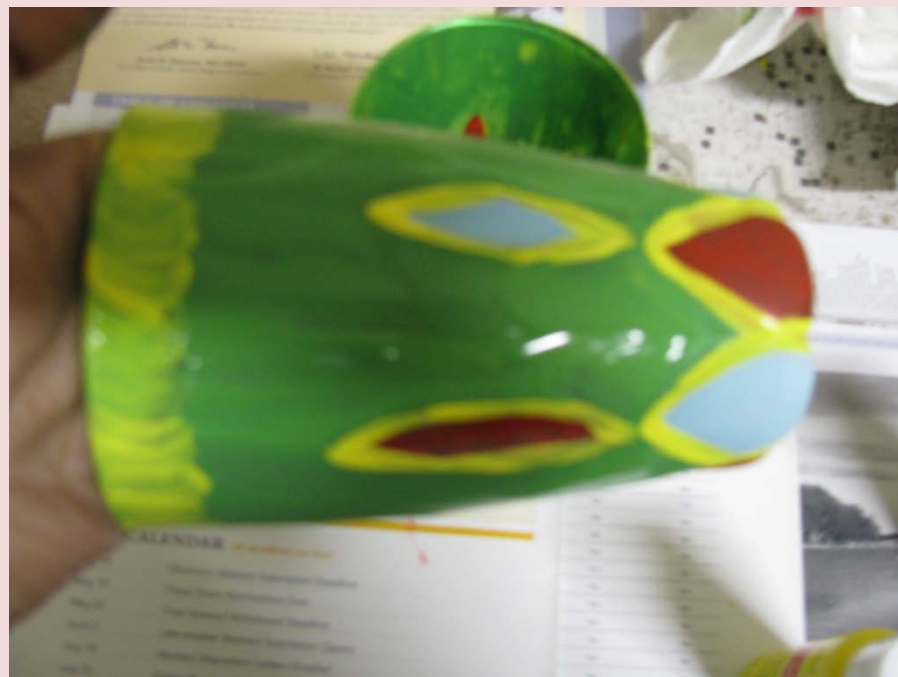
1. Any shape of glass (or even empty glass jar)
2. Different acrylic paints (or glass paints)
3. Brushes
4. White Vinegar and paper towel (Optional)
5. Black Marker (Optional)
6. Tealight
7. Water and Paper Towel

Steps

1. Prepare the glass for painting by dampening paper towel with white vinegar and cleaning the glass to remove any dust, stains and finger tip marks and dry it gently using paper towel.
2. Draw the glass shape on a rough paper and decide the pattern you want to make and the colors you want to use.
3. With Black Marker sketch out the pattern on glass gently
4. Start painting the glass from bottom going towards the top. (This will give you space to hold the glass).



5. Let the glass dry when you reach mid-way before continuing towards the top so that you can hold the glass from bottom.



6. Above picture has double coat of paint. If you prefer more light filtering out when you place tealight inside then use lighter colors and do one coat of paint only.

Tips:
These small little hand painted glasses can serve as vases too.

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
