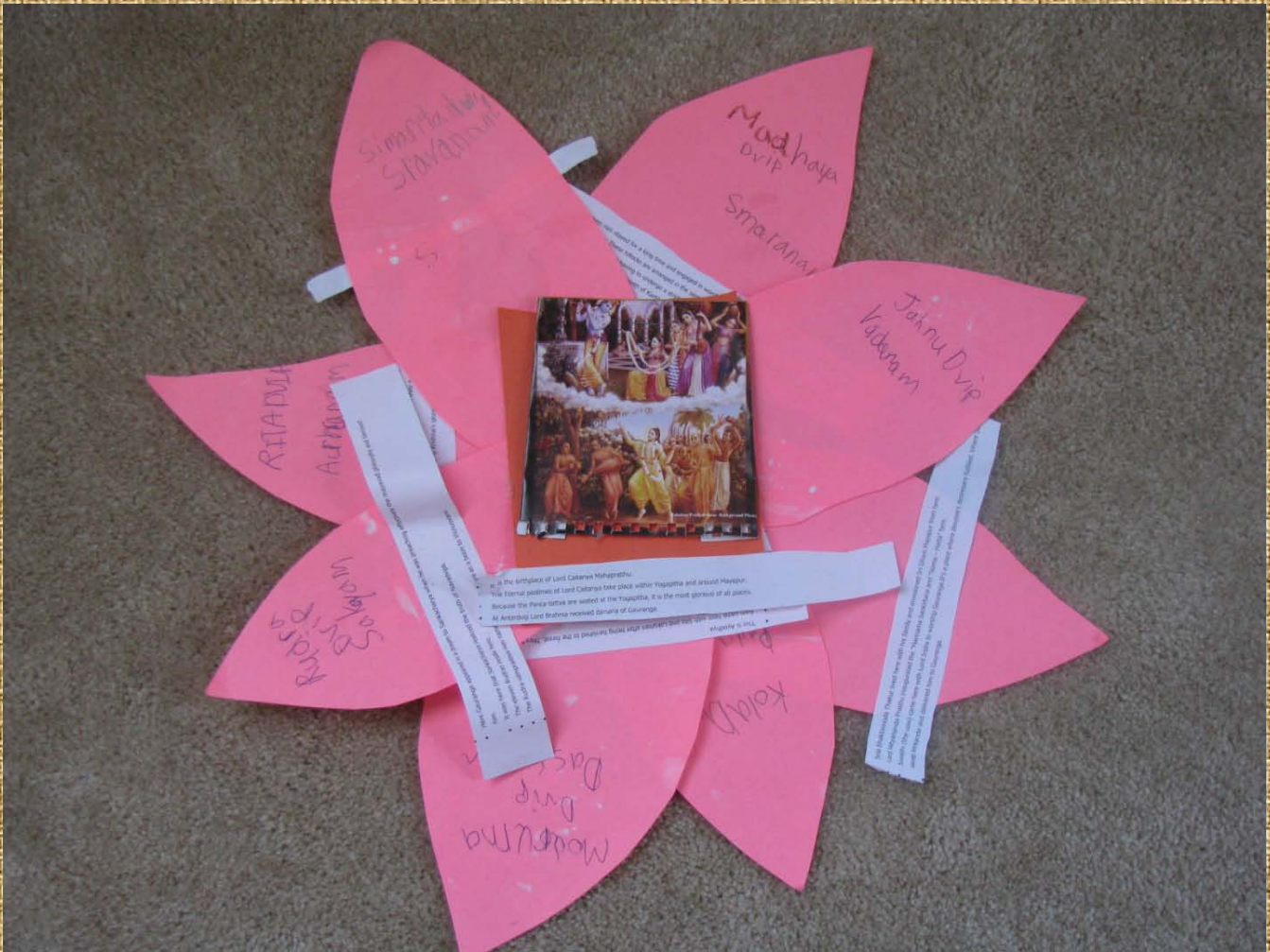


Crafts for Kids

Navadwip Lotus



Materials Required:

1. Pink Construction Paper
2. Scissors
3. Glue
4. Picture of Sankirtan
5. Pen
6. Paper containing information about each island

Steps

1. Cut construction paper to form 8 petals
2. Write each dwip name and significance of each dwip as learnt on petals
3. Stick a small paper containing information about that particular dwip on each petal
4. Glue picture of sankirtan on piece of paper and write name of center dwip "Antardwip"
5. Glue all petals on back of this picture as shown.

More: Navadwip consists of nine islands, which form an eight-petalled lotus that floats on the waters of the Ganges. Eight of the islands form the eight petals of the lotus, and the center of that lotus is the ninth island called Antardwip. The centre of Antardwip is Mayapur. Within Mayapur is the eternal sphere of influence known as Yogapith, the divine birthplace of Sri Chaitanya and eternal pleasure-ground of His Pastimes
