Materials Required:

1. Pictures of all nine incarnations
2. Coloring page related to pastime of each nine incarnations
3. Pastime of each incarnation
4. Any activity pertaining to that incarnation like join the dots, fill in the blanks etc printed out (available on this website)
5. Colors, crayons
6. Glue
7. Scissors

Steps

You can pick one incarnation at a time and work on that booklet at a time.

1. Start by narrating pastime related to that incarnation and show them pictures depicting that pastime
2. Kid's can color and decorate the coloring page according to their understanding of pastime
3. Give them "fill up the blanks" activity related to that pastime or any other activity like "Join the Dots" , "Cross Words" related to that incarnation.
4. Put the work related to one incarnation together by stringing the pages together.
5. Continue to next incarnation.

Tips: Putting the work nicely together encourages the kid and you may choose to go over it with them after a few months to revise what they had learned.
