Paper Lantern




Materials Required:


- 1. Rectangular sheets of construction paper of two colors (two of each color)
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Pencil
- 4. Ruler
- 5. Stapler
- 6. Tissue papers
- 7. A stripe of construction paper to form hanging (or ribbon)

Steps


1. Fold the rectangular sheet into half as shown



2. Using pencil and ruler mark equi-distant lines and cut on these lines leaving 1" as shown



3. Do this for all the sheets and open them.



4. Now staple the 4 sheets together to form lantern. For this staple at corners and 1" inch from corner by placing sheets on top of eachother.



- 5. Cut out small strips from tissue paper and stick them to the bottom of above lantern.
- 6. Staple a thin rectangular strip on a side of lantern to form the hanging loop.

Tips:

You can use different kind of papers and make them in different sizes.
