Tissue Paper Flowers



Materials Required:

1. 2 White (or colored) square tissue papers (for 1 flower)
2. Paper clip (or rubberband or tape)
3. Small scissors
4. Different color markers(sketch pens) optional

Steps

1. Put the two tissue papers on top of each other.
2. Now, fold them in accordion style (back and forth, see picture)



3. Fold this into half.
4. Put a paper clip in center (or put rubberband or tape if required).



5. Cut from the folded side with help of scissors so that we have a butterfly like shape
(You may stop here and color/paint this beautiful butterfly)



6. Now, gently start opening all the tissue papers.



7. Flower is ready, you can trim the leaves if required to make it uniform.
8. Now, color the center with your favorite color marker and very gently color the edges using the marker.

Tips:

You can use more tissue sheets, glossy thin sheets also for this project to get different varieties.
