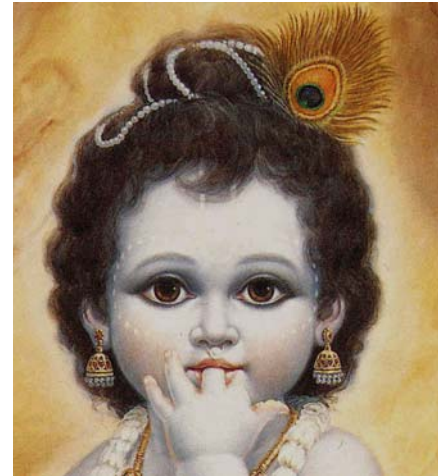

### Who is Bhagavan?

1. Bhagavan: one who possess all opulences in full. (Bhaga-opulences, van- one who possess) that is:

2. We often see a person who may be rich and famous or intelligent and beautiful. However we can never see a person who possesses all these qualities in full.
3. Lord Krsna the supreme personality of Godhead is the only one who possess all these qualities in full therefore He is called 'Bhagavan' ( one who possess all opulences in full)
4. Since, we are all part and parcel of Lord Krishna (Bhagavan); we also possess some of these qualities in small quantities.  
For e.g. - An ocean contains huge quantity of salt. Even a drop of ocean water contains salt, but the only difference is in quantity.
5. Anyone who possesses all the opulences in full is ALL ATTRACTIVE in Sanskrit Krishna means "ALL ATTRACTIVE". No one can be equal to or greater than Krishna.
